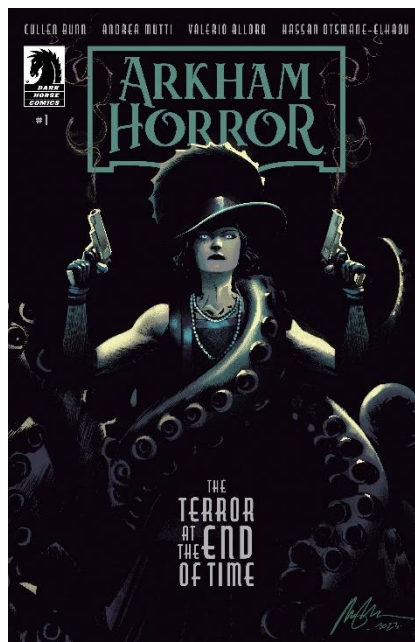
## THE WORLD OF ARKHAM HORROR EXPANDS IN “ARKHAM HORROR: THE TERROR AT THE END OF TIME”

Dark Horse Comics and Asmodee Entertainment present *Arkham Horror: The Terror at the End of Time*, the first comic-based addition to the Arkham Horror universe from Fantasy Flight Games. Eisner Award-nominated master of horror, Cullen Bunn (*Harrow County*, *The Sixth Gun*), will write the four-issue miniseries with art by Andrea Mutti (*Parasomnia*, *The British Paranormal Society*), colors by Valerio Alloro (*Star Wars: Hyperspace Stories*, *Hotel REM*), letters by Hassan Otsmane-Elhaou (*The Witcher: Wild Animals*, *Drive Like Hell*), and cover art by Rafael Albuquerque (*Hailstone*, *Red Tag*). Issue #1 arrives August 2024.

Life is all just one big game to adventuring socialite Jenny Barnes. Or it was, until her sister Izzie was abducted by a dangerous cult.
